# Rules

## Discipline & Code of Conduct

- 1) Every student must obtain on admission the Identity Card which must be his / her photograph duly attested and present it for inspection on demand.
- 2) Students must not loiter in the college premises while the classes are going on.
- 3) Smoking is strictly prohibited in the college premises.
- 4) Students are required to maintain strict discipline and orderly conduct and refrain from engaging themselves in any kind of untruly behavior.
- 5) Students are expected to take proper care of college property and help in keeping the premises clean. Damaging college property e.g. disfiguring walls, doors, fitting or breaking furniture, misuse of A.C. etc. will be considered as a breach of discipline and the guilty will be duly punished.
- 6) Students should not leave their books valuable and other belongings in the classroom.
- 7) The college is not responsible for lost property.
- 8) If for many reason, the continuance of a student in the College is in the opinion of the principal, detrimental to the best interest of the College, the principal may ask such a student to leave the college without assigning reason for his / her decision.
- 9) Students joining the college are bound by the rules and regulations of the college.
- 10) Insubordination and abusive language or misconduct on the part of student are sufficient reasons for his / her suspension or dismissal.
- 11) The students are refrained from using the Mobile Phones in the college premises as per Maharashtra State Secondary & Higher Secondary Manual
- 12) Ragging is strictly prohibited in the college premises.

### **IDENTITY CARD**

A valid Identity Card is issued to every bonafide student at the time of admission. It is compulsory for every student to carry the identity card while being on the campus area. Any loss or Damage to the identity card must be reported to the College office and if required the college office will issue a Duplicate Identity Card against payment of Rs. 100/- Students will not be allowed in the Examination Hall without a valid Identity Card.

### **RAILWAY CONCESSION**

Students can avail concessional fares for rail travel by local trains between the station nearest to the place of their residence and the college.

### **ATTENDANCE**

As per Maharashtra State Secondary & Higher Secondary Board Manual Student is required to attend minimum 75% of the total number of lectures and practicals for the academic year.

## STOP RAGGING

Students of all the Institutions of Leela Education Society are hereby informed that ragging in any form, including obscene words or gesture is prohibited in the State of Maharashtra and is considered a cognizable offence according to the Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act of 1999 of Government of Maharashtra. Student/s found involved in ragging either in the campus or elsewhere outside the campus are liable for prosecution and punishment to the extent of imprisonment for two years and fine of Rs. 10,000/- as well as an instant expulsion from the college and the Hostel. Students should also note that if any student is found involved in ragging or directly / indirectly encouraging it on the campus and outside or even if a complaint is received against him / her for an act of ragging, the legal proceeding against that student will be immediately initiated as per this and the concerned student/s will be instantly expelled from the college and the Hostel.

Those students who have become victims of ragging are advised to lodge their complaints with Rectors / Principal immediately after the incidence.

### **B) LIBRARY RULES**
